#### 2016 ART UNION: Funding the PSQ Grant Scheme

Without the support of our Art Union sponsors and the PSQ clubs and members, the PSQ Grant Scheme would not be possible. Four clubs benefitted from the grant funding: Tin Can Bay Camera Club, Emerald Photographic Club, Bribie Island Photography Club and Surat Shutterbugs, each receiving \$500.

The proceeds from the **2016 Art Union** went towards funding the **PSQ Grant Scheme**. Under this scheme any organisation that is financially affiliated with the PSQ, and that participated in the Art Union for the current period, could apply for funding/assistance. Funding is available for options such as the purchase of photographic/computer hardware, software, and training for members etc. up to a maximum amount of \$1000 per club.

Total grants for the current period equated to a maximum of \$2000, and no single grant could exceed \$1000. As the committee received grant applications from four affiliated clubs, these were assessed, discussed and reviewed at a recent PSQ Committee meeting. With multiple grant requests received, the committee determined to disperse the total \$2000 Grant funds into lesser amounts, equally divided between the four applications, therefore each club received \$500. Application forms for the next round of funding (to be advised) can be requested from our PSQ secretary Gayle Harrison. The PSQ Committee will review and assess the applications once again, before funds are allocated and distributed. Further information is in Ben's President report. 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# PRESIDENTS REPORT Ben Stoffl

#### To all PSQ affiliated organisations,

On Sunday the 22<sup>nd</sup> of January the PSQ Committee met and discussed the applications received under the PSQ Grant Scheme.

Four affiliated organisations applied:

The Bribie Island Photography Club and the Surat Shutterbugs applied for funding of workshops.

The Tin Can Bay Camera Club and the Emerald Photographic Club applied for financial assistance for the purchase of a new laptop.

All applications met the conditions of the Grant Scheme and had been approved by the PSQ Committee. However, due to the number of the applications received, we were not able to award all clubs with the full requested amounts. As we were committed under the Grant Scheme to award a total amount of \$2000 per year, we decided to distribute that amount equally to all four applicants.

#### We also made the following decisions for the future:

Any PSQ affiliated organisation can receive a maximum of \$1000 per application.

A maximum of four applications per year will be approved, with the granted amount for each application decided by the PSQ Committee.

Grant applications will be assessed on merit, with consideration given for the capacity to effectively support and deliver photographic skills/improvement, and increase membership/involvement in photographic endeavours. For example, applications that help running club events by way of equipment or by holding of workshops/seminars to assist in distributing photographic knowledge and skills will be favorably considered.

If there are more than four applications it will be at the discretion of the PSQ Committee which clubs will be granted and which will be rejected.

I assume you all know that that the money for the Grant Scheme is derived from the sale of tickets of the PSQ Art Union. This was very thankfully sponsored last year by: 'Streets Imaging Services', 'Lowepro', 'Velbon', 'Silvershotz', and 'Garricks Camerahouse' in Rockhampton.

Last year the participation of affiliated organisations in the sale of PSQ Art Union Tickets was quite successful – but under even more favourable conditions could even be better in coming years!

Because, I personally believe (i.e. this has not been discussed by the PSQ Committee) if the income of the Art Union is considerably higher than last year, perhaps the total amount of \$2000 per year, and perhaps the maximum of the application to be considered granted, can be increased in the future.

Therefore is up to all of us to: sell / buy more PSQ Art Union Tickets!

QCCC Brookfield 29,30 Apr, 1 May 2017



The **PSQ2017 Convention** is just around the corner and we hope your members will want to join us at this year's venue: - **QCCC Brookfield** (<a href="www.qccc.org.au/discover-brookfield">www.qccc.org.au/discover-brookfield</a>) 179 Gold Creek Road, Brookfield Qld 4069, just a short drive from Kenmore in Brisbane's leafy Western Suburbs.

The Convention will take place over the May Day Long Weekend - Sat 29<sup>th</sup> & Sun 30<sup>th</sup> April & Mon 1<sup>st</sup> May.

This year's **Camera Clubs Get-Together** will focus on the members of PSQ's Affiliated Clubs, Groups & Societies. We have sourced a number of very informative guest speakers from within Queensland's Camera Clubs as well as non-camera club presenters. Each of the daily programmes will include Presentations, Q & A Sessions, and afternoon Workshops & Photoshoot opportunities both on-site and out and about in the Brookfield hinterland. Most meals, breakfast through to dinner, will be catered for at the venue with the exception of the Sunday Night Gala Dinner which is planned to be held off-site at the Brookfield Show Grounds Hall.

QCCC Brookfield has very good, yet cost effective, on-site accommodation including multiple roomed units. We recommend you book early to reserve your unit. Single Registrants may be required to share a unit.

Once again attendance costs have been our utmost consideration primarily because we understand that delegates from outside of Brisbane also incur heavy travel costs, so keeping the Registration fees down have been a major priority!

- 1) We have capped the "top of the line" Registration rate this year at **\$380.00/Person** for 3 Days. Includes **On-site** accommodation & meals. (Breakfast and Saturday Night Pub Quiz Dinner Included) Early Bird bookings (prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> April) discounted to **\$350.00/Person**.
- 2) Daily <u>On-site</u> Registrations at **\$140.00/Person** including On-site accommodation & meals. Once again with an Early Bird booking option (prior to 1<sup>st</sup> April) discounted to **\$125.00/Person**. Saturday Night Pub Quiz Dinner **not** included.
- 3) Full Long Weekend Registration (3 Days) <u>without On-site</u> accommodation at **\$260.00**. The Saturday Night Pub Quiz Dinner is included. Early Bird bookings discounted to **\$240.00/Person**






