Retired in 2024 from the Queensland Department of Agriculture and Fisheries as an Extension Agronomist. My main photographic interests are in nature, macro, landscape and people. I have been entering National and International Competitions since 2007.

I have been a member of the Toowoomba Photographic Society since 2004. Currently I am President of the Society. I became a PSQ Accredited judge in 2009 and have judged over 140 competitions since then. I am also a member of the Australian Photographic Judges Association and endeavour to undertake regular upskilling in photographic judging.

My image evaluation workflow focuses on four key areas:

1. Compliance (with the competition rules)
2. Concept (the emotional impact, point of interest and story in the image)
3. Aesthetic (image composition, artistic elements, design principles and presentation)
4. Technical (appropriateness of lighting, exposure, depth of field, noise, sharpness, blur, and issues that may detract from image impact).

I aim to be supportive and constructive in the feedback I provide image makers - providing advice where I feel it will strengthen their image, and awarding awards in a consistent manner.
