River City Prints Competition

The judging of interclub competition, River City Prints, will take place Saturday July 30 in Brisbane and all PSQ camera club members are welcome to attend to watch this exciting event!

President of host club Queensland Camera Group, Martin Riley, said he was excited that the competition had received a great response following a two year hiatus due to Covid 19.


"So far, River City Prints has attracted interest from 12 clubs across Queensland, with entries remaining open until July 16," Martin said. "We're hoping that individual members will come along to the impact judging afternoon to catch up with members from across Queensland and to witness the judging of some high-calibre printed images."

Club entries will feature 20 prints, consisting of four prints in each of five sections including open colour, open monochrome, nature, portrait/people and non-A Grade open. The club gaining the highest overall number of points will be awarded the perpetual trophy, kindly sponsored by the PSQ. First place getters in each of the sections will be awarded a certificate, along with the champion print which will be selected from each of the first place winners.

The judging will be held at the Queensland Camera Group clubhouse, (that is SPACE Communitfy Hall), corner Branton and Paley Streets, Kenmore Hills. It starts at 1.00 pm and the \$10 entry fee includes afternoon tea.

Invitations to the judging will be sent to all PSQ camera clubs in early July. Registration will be via a link so look out for note from your club secretary, but put the date in your diary in the meantime.

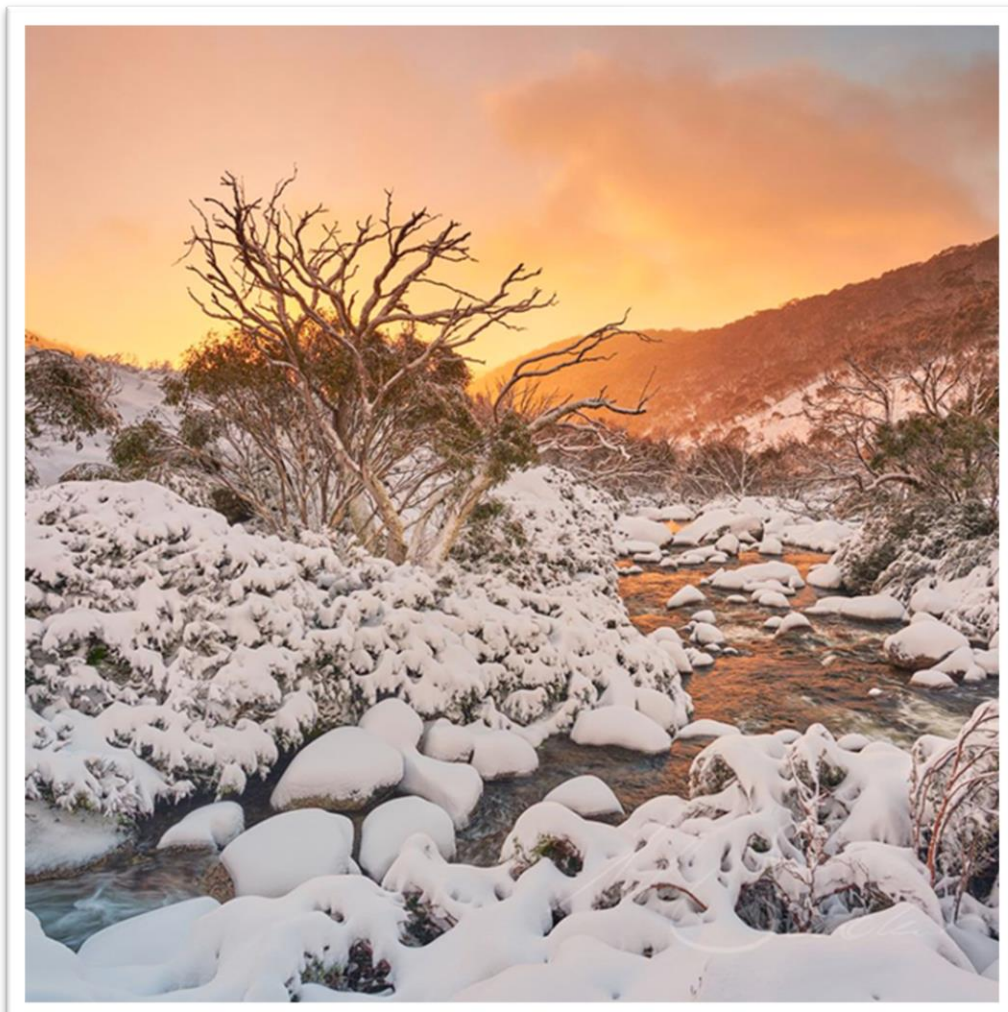
